

# MHMR Visions – August 2018 Impact Summary

## Disability Services

### Activities:

- Weekly music therapy, yoga and art instruction for program participants at ABG and ACS.
- Group home residents enjoyed birthday celebrations at local restaurants.
- Volunteers from the Chula Chasers Motorcycle Club and MHMR staff assembled sheds and picnic tables for group home residents (see pictures right).

### Purchases:

- Special Olympics supplies and training items for athletes.
- Supplies for ABG recreational art and Friendship Groups.
- Gift cards for 100 families to purchase back-to-school supplies.

## Early Childhood Services (ECS)

- United Way of Wise County funds helped pay for a family support coach as part of Milestones.

## Behavioral Health (BH)

### Community Center for individuals with severe and persistent mental illness

- The August birthday celebration was attended by 73 people.

## Substance Use Disorder (SUDS) – The Campus

- To reward positive behavior and progress, Colonial Country Club Charities funds were used to purchase gaming supplies for the residential game room.
- Adolescents attended four sessions of equine therapy (see pictures right and below).

## Veterans Services (VS)

- An ongoing grant from The Jewish War Veterans helped purchase 16 fuel cards for veterans to travel to work and school.
