Disability Services

Activities:

- Group home residents enjoyed birthday celebrations at local restaurants.
- Approximately 150 people attended the October Friendship Group luncheon.
- A group of ABG participants saw the movie *Goosebumps 2*.

Purchases:

- Beads that will be distributed to ABG participants on their birthdays.
- Baseball caps for the Special Olympics team.
- Videos for ABG.

Early Childhood Services (ECS)

- United Way of Wise County funds helped pay for a family support coach as part of Milestones.
- Visions funds purchased food and refreshments for 14 Parent Cafés that were attended by 531 people.

Behavioral Health (BH)

Community Center for individuals with severe and persistent mental illness

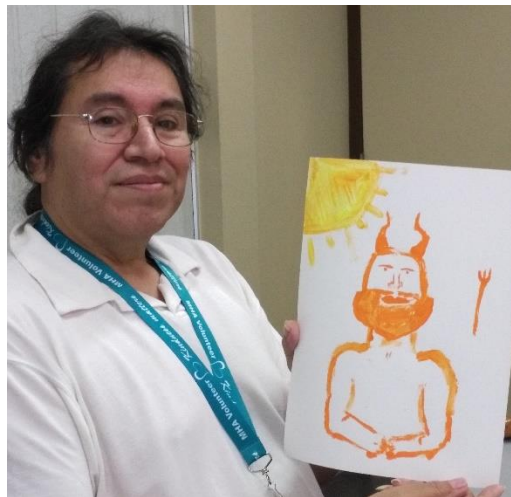
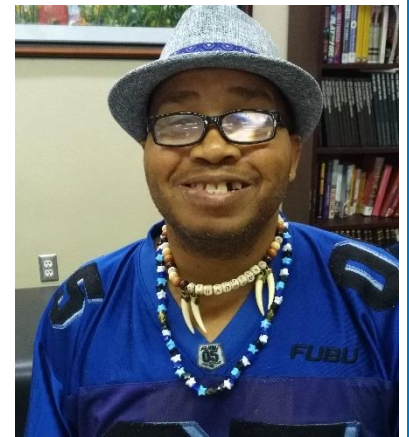
- Supplies for arts and crafts were purchased. (See pictures right and below.)
